

TIBBETS PTA MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 9, 2021

Lisa called the meeting to order at 6:01pm. She welcomed everyone and reminded all that the PTA does have a spot on the agenda for our local business to have a chance to chat at the monthly meetings. Sarah C asked the group to review the November meeting minutes. Katie J made a motion to approve and Jodi 2nd, motion passed unanimously. Nicole had a few deposits; scrip, spiritwear, and various donations. A few of the November Calendar raffle winners donated their winnings back to the PTA, thank you! She did mention that there were a few budget busts, as in we received more donations than projected. Nicole will be a motion to shift the budget numbers around at the next PTA meeting. Sarah C made a motion to approve the budget and Katie J 2nd, motion passed.

Jodi announced that the PTA will be doing the Winter Wonderland decorations and activities again this year instead of a PTA FFN. There will be swag bags sent home on monday with some goodies and a coloring contest sheet. There will be 1 winter per grade level and 1 staff winner. Jodi also mentioned that some dress up days have been added to the mix: Monday the 13th- Red/Green day, Friday the 17th - Holiday Bling day, Monday the 20th- Holiday Hat day, and Tuesday the 21st- Holiday Pajama Day.

MR. Frost reported that Trimester 1 is over and reports went home on Thursday. 5th grade had their "Give it Back" day in which they went around the school and assisted younger students and others with their tasks. 4th grade had a Harry Potter Day, and Friday the 10th was Packer/Bears day. Mrs. Seye-Pyle has been working hard to prepare the students for the recorded holiday concert and December 22-January 2 is Tibbets winter break. Mr. Frost also mentioned that there has been an up-tick of covid cases at the school, with 10 active cases currently. He stated that the biggest hurdle is the lack of isolation at home when multiple family members are on different quarantine schedules due to exposure.

He announced that DPI has submitted their school report cards and Tibbets received an 88.8%. If you would like more information on this please contact the school office.

Ashley B announced that all 23 children listed on the Giving Tree sign up were spoken for within a few days! Kayla C has made arrangements for the Holiday Staff Lunch, Mama T's will be making a few pasta dishes and they will be delivered to the school on Friday the 17th.

The Santa Cruise has started, please use the Tibbets code when booking. January and February FFN planning is in the works, please keep a lookout for more to come.

The few spirit wear items that were on backorder are in and will be sent home soon.

Cheryl K sent an email updating the PTA on the stencils. She and Brenda walked around Tibbets with Mr. Frost to figure out a plan and how much paint is needed. Unfortunately Tibbets was not approved for the grant to help with the cost of supplies. They estimate the paint will cost around \$2000. (It was unclear as to whether the paint costs are for just Tibbets or for all the schools, Sarah C will reach out to Cheryl to clarify.) They will be filling out other grant applications and asked if anyone else knows of places to reach out to please let them or the PTA board know.

The pop tab palooza will start on Feb. 17 and go to March 3, with a dress up date of March 10. Start saving those pop tabs!
